
THE RULES ARE SIMPLE -

- Ine continuous flight crossing the Pennine Way, either way, no stopping off for extra fuel,
- Length of flight to be measured in kilometres 'as the crow flies',
- Competition is open to club members of either the North West Balloon and Airship Club (NWBAC), or the Pennine Region Balloon Association (PRBA), or both.
- No limit on the number of times a pilot may enter per year,
- Intries to be received by the 5th January in the following year.
